TERMS & CONDITIONS

By participating in the Birmingham Mail Fun Run for Macmillan Cancer Support you are deemed to have agreed to the following terms and conditions:

An entry fee of £10 for adults (12 years and over) is payable. The entry fee for 8 - 11 year olds is £7.

You accept that Macmillan Cancer Support is not liable for your health or possessions during the run and that you participate at your own risk.

You are entering the Fun Run of your own volition and therefore confirm that your general state of health and fitness is good and that you understand that any injury sustained by you during the event is your own responsibility and not the responsibility of Macmillan Cancer Support.

A maximum of 5000 entrants are permitted for the event. Entry forms must be received by Macmillan Cancer Support by 24 April 2009, unless the maximum number of entries is received before that date (look in the local media and on the Macmillan website for updates). Entries on the day at the event will not be permitted. Please send your completed Entry Form(s) in as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.

GOODS AND SERVICES

All participants in the Fun Run will receive a T-shirt, goody bag and medal.

In the spirit of the event, participants may wear fancy dress but are advised to wear appropriate footwear.

Please note if you have already received a t-shirt from the 2008 event, you will not be sent another for the 2009 event as this will greatly help reduce the costs of the event to the charity.

RETURNS AND REFUNDS

No refunds will be given under any circumstances excepting those where the organisers of the Fun Run are found to be in monetary error. Refunds for those who find they are unable to take part in the Fun Run are at the discretion of the management of Macmillan Cancer Support. This does not affect your statutory rights.

SPONSORSHIP

Please endeavour to raise a minimum of £50 sponsorship for Macmillan Cancer Support in addition to the entry fee - it will make a massive difference to the lives of people living with cancer.

You must return any sponsorship monies collected by you to your sponsors if you are unable to participate for any reason (including ill health).

Should your sponsors agree that the monies may be donated to Macmillan Cancer Support in any event, you must ask the sponsors to countersign the sponsorship form to confirm their agreement and arrange for the donated monies to be paid to Macmillan Cancer Support. All funds raised for Macmillan Cancer Support through the Fun Run must be paid by way of cash or cheques payable to Macmillan Cancer Support and forwarded to Macmillan Cancer Support, Birmingham by 1st June 2009.
