And now is the perfect time to get out onto the fairways in style. The little white ball with a mind of its own provides everyone from professional golfers to newcomers to the sport with fresh challenges every day.

Golf is a sociable sport. Discussing techniques, clubs, approaches and strategies is all part of the fun - not to mention the camaraderie of the clubhouse.

If you are new to the sport, visiting a golfing range will give you a feel for the game. When the bug bites, you can channel your raw talent with tuition at golfing ranges or from a PGA professional.

Private clubs usually require you to be at a certain level before you

can play on them, so check before booking. You can usually pay an agreed fee for a round, which is cheaper if you can play with someone who is already a member.

Be sure to familiarise yourself with golfing etiquette, either from an experienced friend, or your tutor, as there are definite dos and don'ts designed to protect everyone's enjoyment.

If time is not a problem for you, then you can enjoy the luxury of playing off-peak at reduced rates, by negotiating a restricted membership. Local clubs will also be happy to provide you with details of their membership and subscription packages.

Golf clubs vary according to the type of stroke you intend to take. For example, woods are for tee and long fairway shots, whilst irons are for approach shots of varying lengths to the green.

Lower numbered irons are designed for distance, and vice versa. Wedges are used to get out of troublesome bunkers or when close to the green; and the putter is used to roll the ball onto the green and into the hole.

Inspired? Then why not try a game of golf? It could be the start of a healthy addiction!
