*There is much more to this area than originally meets the eye. In the 1800s it was home to a spa baths which at one stage was expected to rival the town of Harrogate in popularity.

*In the mid 1800s Chapel Hill was home to a lodging house and records from 1917 show that the house was extremely busy with male lodgers, single females and married couples.

*Lockwood Railway Station is on the Penistone Line between Huddersfield and Sheffield. Situated in Swan Lane, it is just before the Grade 11 listed 32-arched Lockwood Viaduct which spans the valley to Berry Brow.

*The Lockwood Bar junction is one of the busiest in Huddersfield with traffic passing through for Meltham and the Holme Valley.

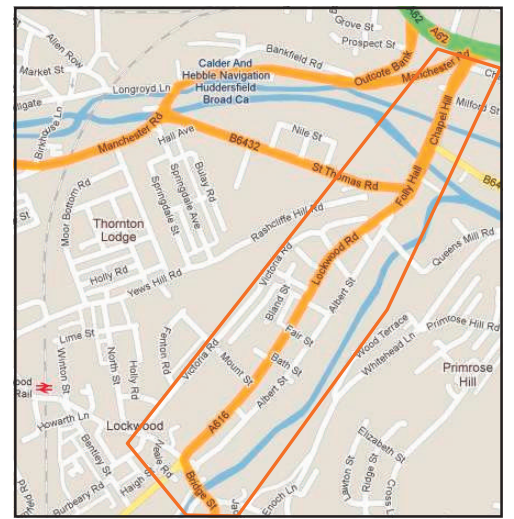
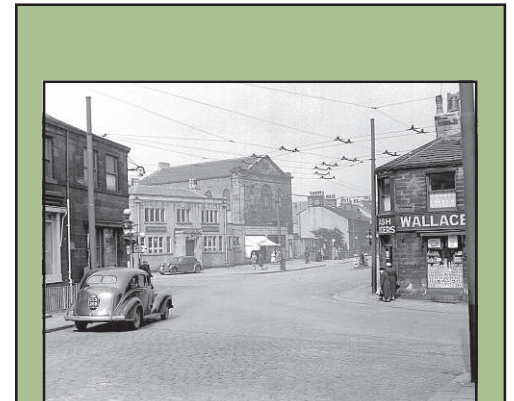
