With reference to the above Possession Proceedings on the 10th October 2009 I write to ~~WITHDRAW~~ my application due to the fact that I do not stand a chance with all the police as witnesses, you will obviously believe the police over me. Had the witnesses been the general public in my area I know there would not be a case to fight. As you can appreciate whilst I am in prison to call on neighbours etc myself to seek their support.

I feel I have been treated very unfair regarding my house where I have been a tenant for 11 years. My daughter who is 25 and looking after my 11-year old son has also been suffering with all the stress of worrying, has she got to find somewhere else for them to live.

Also regarding the rent arrears when I came to prison my daughter got in touch with Riverside and asked that although the tenancy was in my name could she continue making the rent payments for which she would have set up a Direct Debit but they wouldn't allow her to do this. Therefore that is the reason why rent arrears have accrued.

However I will of course pay these arrears and no doubt Riverside will be in touch with me, not my daughter, in the near future with


regard to making arrangements for payment.

I do not want to make house and neither does my son or daughter but feel I cannot cope any longer with this stress whilst in prison knowing I do not have a chance against the police

I therefore reiterate that I am withdrawing my application for possession on the 7th October 2009

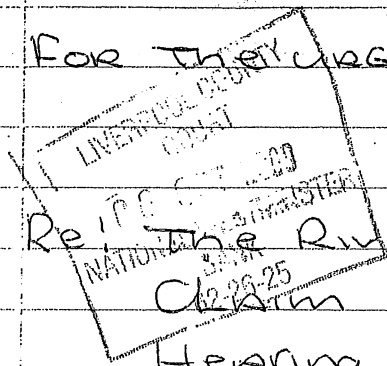

With regrets I will not be attending the trial dated 7th - 13th October. as the only witnesses are police officers and feel I don't have the strength to go through with this. I don't want to lose my home my daughter is now on medication due to our stress of becoming homeless. her brother Joseph age 14 Does stay with Danielle every weekend Danielle + Joseph are very close. you can confirm this with Joseph's father he said he would be happy to do this Riverside do have Mr McCormick's telephone number.

on my release may or September 2010 Joseph will be returning full time with me this has been agreed with Joseph's father. I would also like to point out. that Danielle is now unemployed claiming sickness benefit so she is eligible for housing benefit but Riverside have told Danielle because she's not on the tenancy agreement housing benefit will not be granted. as we said an amount I am prepared to pay back my

Rent arrears thats not a problem, I would like the trial to go ahead without me being present. I will wait for the outcome, and I do so hope Danielle and her brother wont be evicted, as a family we will agree to any terms decided by yourself and Riverside, all of the neighbours or good shepherd do have told Danielle they are happy for us to stay. I have even received letter of 2 of my neighbours asking how I was doing. if I get to keep my family home myself Danielle and Joseph will only be living at the property and as you know my son Sam wont be coming home for 2 years. I would also like to point out the claimants solicitors Drabners I have written to the governor at Drake hall the prison I am held at. If you read the letter it says anti social behaviour the prison must think this applies to me but it does not. I am very upset by this comment. I am very sorry I am not attending but I hope you respect my decision.
